


R Markdown Installation Instructions

1. Make sure you have previously installed R and RStudio in the earlier module.
2. Directions and a video for installing R Markdown are shown at:

3. Open CRAN – the R installed earlier (preferred over RStudio). Type the command in the interface – `install.packages("rmarkdown")`

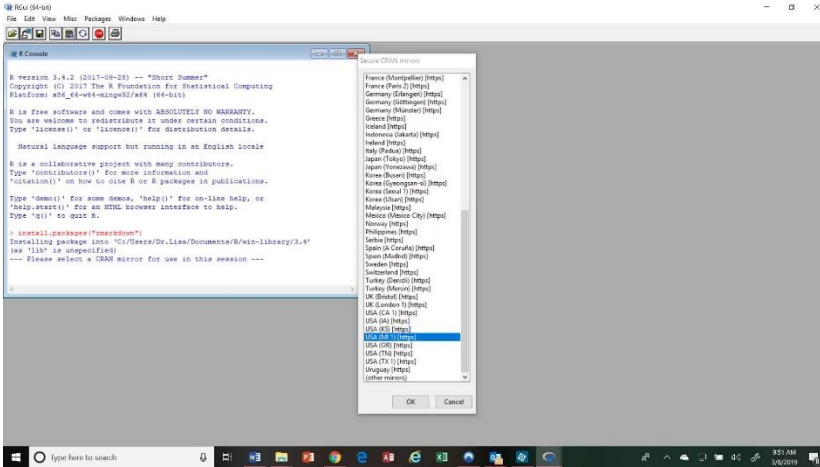

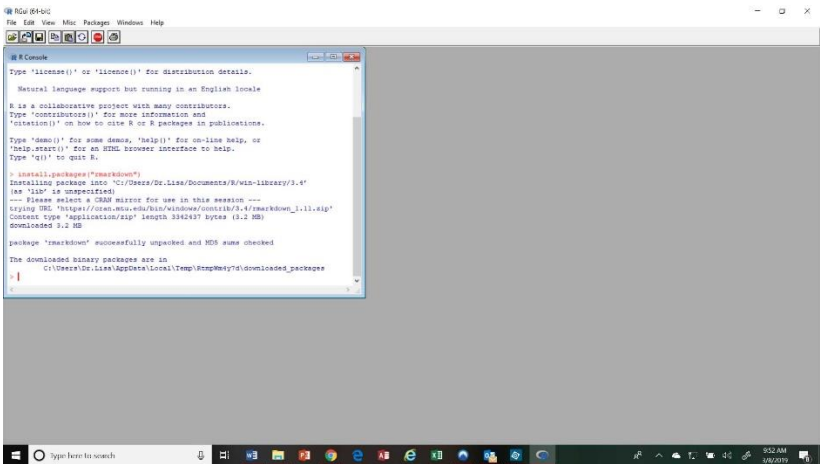

4. Select the mirror site – pick a site in the U.S.



5. Make sure you answer any pop-up questions if they ask you for permission.



6. You should get the message the rmarkdown successfully unpacked and the check sum checked. Your package installation of rmarkdown is complete. You are now able to call this package.
